WILSON - Benjamin, April 14 [1926], beloved brother of Morris, Michael, and William Gincig, Pauline [nee Ginzig] Nelson. Funeral from Stephen Merritts's Chapel, 233 8th Av., Friday, April 16, 1:30 P.M.

I have 2 Charles Gincig/Ginzig listed in 1880 Census and various city directories. I am wondering if in 1880 they were in the process of moving and so had the two households, but then there's the 1870 that throws everything out the window. Really, really, really need help figuring all this out. Keep in mind that Krakow was once in Austria and many spoke German and so were listed as German in censuses. Also, Michael (date unknown) and Bernard (1903) changed their last name to Wilson. I do have all these documents just need to connect the dots. Thank you.

He married ROSA "ROSALIE/RACHEL" MEIZEL/MUNTZER March 18, 1852 in Krakow, Poland, daughter of SUSSEL MUNTZER and PAULINE EYBYSCHYTZ. She was born Bet. 1835 - 1837 in Krakow, Austria/Poland, and died February 28, 1902 in Manhattan, New York, New York.
